NOTICE OF AMENDED PETITION TO ADMINISTER ESTATE OF CATHY ELLEN SWEENEY Case No. 20STPB08224

To all heirs, beneficiaries, creditors,
contingent creditors, and persons
who may otherwise be interested in
the will or estate, or both, of CATHY
ELLEN SWEENEY
AN AMENDED PETITION FOR PRO-
BATE has been filed by John E.
Sweeney in the Superior Court of
California, County of LOS ANGELES.
THE AMENDED PETITION FOR
PROBATE requests that John E.
Sweeney be appointed as personal
representative to administer the es-
tate of the decedent.

THE AMENDED PETITION requests
the decedent's will and codicils, if
any, be admitted to probate. The will
and any codicils are available for ex-
amination in the file kept by the court.
THE AMENDED PETITION requests
authority to administer the estate un-
der the Independent Administration of
Estates Act. (This authority will allow
the personal representative to take
many actions without obtaining court
approval. Before taking certain very
important actions, however, the per-
sonal representative will be required
to give notice to interested persons
unless they have waived notice or
consented to the proposed action.)
The independent administration au-
thority will be granted unless an inter-
ested person files an objection to the
petition and shows good cause why
the court should not grant the author-
ity.

A HEARING on the amended peti-
tion will be held on June 24, 2021 at
8:30 AM in Dept. No. 67 located at
111 N. Hill St., Los Angeles, CA
90012.

IF YOU OBJECT to the granting of
the petition, you should appear at the
hearing and state your objections or
file written objections with the court
before the hearing. Your appearance
may be in person or by your attorney.
IF YOU ARE A CREDITOR or a con-
tingent creditor of the decedent, you
must file your claim with the court and
mail a copy to the personal repres-
entative appointed by the court with-
in the later of either (1) four months
from the date of first issuance of let-
ters to a general personal represent-
ative, as defined in section 58(b) of
the California Probate Code, or (2) 60
days from the date of mailing or per-
sonal delivery to you of a notice un-
der section 9052 of the California
Probate Code.

Other California statutes and legal
authority may affect your rights as a
creditor. You may want to consult
with an attorney knowledgeable in
California law.

YOU MAY EXAMINE the file kept by
the court. If you are a person inter-
ested in the estate, you may file with
the court a Request for Special No-
tice (form DE-154) of the filing of an
inventory and appraisal of estate as-
sets or of any petition or account as
provided in Probate Code section
1250. A Request for Special Notice
form is available from the court clerk.
