Re: Activation of Stage 1 Mandatory Water Conservation and Public Meeting¹

Dear Valued Customer:

On June 10, 2022, SCE submitted a Tier 2 Advice Letter with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) to activate Stage 1 of SCE's Schedule 14.1 Staged Mandatory Water Conservation and Rationing Plan (Water Rationing Plan) for the Catalina Island water system.² SCE is activating Stage 1 because the water level in the Middle Ranch Reservoir is forecast to drop below the 600-acre-foot level in June 2022.

Effective July 11, 2022, Stage 1 Mandatory Water Conservation will be in effect. Stage 1 includes restrictions and prohibitions on non-essential water use. Key Stage 1 restrictions and prohibitions include, but are not limited to, the following3:

- Use of potable water through any meter when SCE has notified the customer in writing to
- Use of potable water 1) that results in flooding or runoff, 2) for washing buildings, structures, and other hard-surfaced areas, 3) washing of private or commercial cars or other vehicles except with the use of a positive action shut-off nozzle, three-gallon bucket, or fixed equipment to avoid wasteful use, 4) for construction purposes, 5) watering or irrigation except by drip irrigation or using a positive action shut-off nozzle or three-gallon bucket, and 6) for the filling or refilling of swimming pools, spas, hot tubs, or decorative fountains.
- Operation of commercial car washes without recycling at least 50% of the water used pe cycle.
- Service of water by any restaurant except upon the request of a patron
- Use of fresh water from fire hydrants, at any time, for any purpose other than fire suppres-
- Use of potable water to irrigate ornamental turf on public medians
- Use of potable water to irrigate landscapes during and within 48 hours of measurable rainfall.
- Use of potable water to irrigate landscapes outside of newly constructed homes and buildings in a manner inconsistent with regulations or other requirements established by the California Building Standards Commission and the Department of Housing and Community
- Operators of hotel, motels or similar business establishments providing overnight accomoperators of interest, indees or similar business establishments providing overhight accom-modations shall provide guests with the option of choosing not to have towels and linens laundered daily. The operators of these establishments shall prominently display notice of this option in each guestroom using clear and easily understood language.
- Watering or irrigation is limited to the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., during the period Pacific Daylight Time is in effect, and 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., during the period Pacific Standard Time is in effect.

Enforcement and Appeal Procedure

If a customer is observed using water for any nonessential or unauthorized used, SCE may charge a violation fine in accordance with Section E of Schedule 14.1.

Any customer requesting a variance needs to notify SCE in writing at P.O. Box 527, Avalon, CA 90704, explaining the reason for such a variation. If the customer disagrees with SCE's decision regarding the variance, the customer may file a complaint with the CPUC by visiting www.cpuc.ca.gov.

Conservation Devices

SCE will make water conservation devices available to customers receiving residential service at Avalon City Hall or upon request by contacting SCE via email at catalinawater@sce.com. These devices can help you save water without impacting your comfort.

Public Meeting

SCE will hold a public meeting to provide information on the mandatory conservation measures and the availability of water conservation devices. The public meeting will occur during the normally scheduled Avalon City Council meeting:
