NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on February 1, 2024, the City of Avalon will begin annual registration for all full size Residential Vehicles (blue stickers) and Autoette (Golf Cart) permits, and will continue through April 1, 2024. Mo torcycles no longer require a City of Avalon decal. Vehicle permits renewed after this date shall be considered late, and will be required to pay a "late renewal charge" of \$30.00 per vehicle in addition to the regular registration fee.

You also must bring a current vehicle registration, proof of ownership or lawful possession, and be prepared to provide proof of residency or non-resident real property ownership since April 18, 1989. The owner of a full size residential vehicle(s) must be present to register sticker
