ANNUAL VEHICLE REGISTRATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on February 3, 2025, the City of Avalon will begin annual Registration for all full size Residential Vehicles (blue stickers) and Autoette (Golf Cart) permits, and will continue through April 1, 2025. Vehicle permits renewed after this date shall be considered late, and will be required to pay a "late renewal charge" of \$30.00 per vehicle in addition to the regular registration fee.

Full size residential vehicle permits shall be ineligible for renewal and shall be subject to losing all prior rights of registration if not renewed before 5:00 p.m. on Monday, June 2, 2025.

Applicants must bring current vehicle registration, proof of ownership or lawful possession, and be prepared to provide proof of residency or non-resident real property ownership. **The owner of a full size residential vehicle(s), autoette(s) and non-residential autoette(s) must be present to register sticker. If the owner is unavailable, a letter must be provided from the owner designating a responsible person on their behalf.**

The fee for renewal is \$50.00 for permits. All renewals and payments may be completed online at: www.cityofavalon.com/vehicles and will result in expedited sticker service.

ALL OUTSTANDING TRAFFIC CITATIONS MUST BE TAKEN CARE OF BEFORE VEHICLE STICKERS ARE ISSUED (www.citationprocessingcenter.com).

CITY OF AVALON PUBLIC NOTICE OF ORDINANCE AMENDMENT ORDINANCE NO. 1223-25

Notice is hereby given that on March 4, 2025, the City Council adopted an Ordinance entitled:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AVALON REPEALING AND REPLACING TITLE 4, CHAPTER 4-1 AND REPEALING CHAPTER 4-10 OF THE AVALON MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING BICYCLES, ELECTRIC BICYCLES, AND MOTORIZED BICYCLES

The following is a summary of the Ordinance amendment:

- It repeals and replaces Avalon Municipal Code § 4-1 and repeals § 4-10 of the Avalon Municipal Code.
- The scope of the ordinance is the use, registration, and control of bicycles operated on the public right of way, as well as certain restrictions applicable to skates, rollerblades, and skateboards.
- It requires all bicycles to be registered with the Vehicle Clerk by filing an application, and that each registered bicycle, electric bicycle, or motorized bicycle be assigned a number kept on file in the Vehicle Clerk, and that an identification tag be affixed to each bicycle. Any change in the ownership or dismantling of a bicycle must be reported to the Vehicle Clerk within 10 days of such event.
- It provides certain operational regulations, generally requiring bicycles to obey rules applicable to drivers of vehicles. It prohibits bicycles from operating on certain roadways, as specified in the ordinance. It imposes a maximum speed for bicycles of 20 miles per hour. Among other operational restrictions, it imposes parking standards, limitations on where the bicycles may be ridden, age and licensing restrictions, and limits on the total number of riders on bicycles.
- It regulates the impoundment and storage of bicycles that have been towed and stored when found in violation of the ordinance, provides the notice period for such removal, and the process for recovery of bicycles stored by the City, as well as applicable storage fees.
- It further regulates the allowable times and places for the use of skates, rollerblades, and skateboards or other similar wheeled devices.

Ordinance No. 1223-25 was introduced and waived at the regular City Council Meeting on February 4, 2025 and adopted at the March 4, 2025 regular City Council Meeting by the following vote: AYES: Mayor Marshall, Councilmembers De La Rosa, Lavelle, Ponce and Schickling; NAYS: None; ABSTAIN: None; ABSENT: None.
