AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF AVALON, CALIFORNIA ESTABLISHING CHAPTERS 10-8 AND
10-9 OF THE AVALON MUNICIPAL CODE SETTING FORTH RULES AND
REGULATIONS FOR USE OF AVALON BEACHES AND PARKS
The Ordinance will add Chapters 10-8 (Public Use of Beaches and Parks) and
10-9 (Park Rules) to Title 10 of the Avalon Municipal Code. The Ordinance imposes requirements on the use of City of Avalon beaches and parks to preserve the natural beauty, public safety, and availability of those beaches and parks. The Ordinance will prohibit fires, overnight camping, littering, consuming alcohol, and disturbing the peace in all beaches and parks. Any gathering of twenty or more people in a City beach or park will require a permit and area reserved haead of time.
All beachgoers must stay in compliance with the Ordinance's regulations to remain on a City beach. Regulations that only apply to beaches include prohibitions on using glass containers, smoking, bringing animals to the beach or water, selling or renting goods, and littering into the ocean. Anyone fishing at a City beach must consider the safety of other beachgoers are present. Under the Ordinance, the public cannot be on the beach from midnight until 6:00 a.m. unless they are trying to access the ocean or attending a special event authorized by the City.
The Ordinance prohibits the use of all City parks outside of the regular park hours of dawn to 10:00 p.m. without authorization from the City. The public cannot be on the beach good and park property engaging in commercial activities, posting items, and using a barbecute that was not provided by the City.
The Ordinance prohibited without a permit. The Ordinance prohibited can reserve space in the park for up to 6 hours; roping off an area or setting up outdoor furniture is prohibited without a permit. The Ordinance prohibits driving
