ANNUAL VEHICLE REGISTRATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on February 2, 2026, the City of Avalon will begin annual Registration for all full-size Residential Vehicles and Autoette (Golf Cart) permits, and will continue through April 1, 2026. Vehicle permits renewed after this date shall be considered late and will be required to pay a "late renewal charge" of \$30.00 per vehicle in addition to the regular registration fee.

Full size residential vehicle permits shall be ineligible for renewal and shall be subject to losing all prior rights of registration if not renewed before 5:00 p.m. on Monday, June 1, 2026.

Applicants must bring current vehicle registration, proof of ownership or lawful possession, and be prepared to provide proof of residency or non-resident real property ownership. **The owner of a full-size residential vehicle(s), autoette(s) and non-residential autoette(s) must be present to register sticker. If the owner is unavailable, a letter must be provided from the owner designating a responsible person on their behalf.**

The fee for renewal is \$50.00 for permits. All renewals and payments may be completed online at: www.cityofavalon.gov/vehicles and will result in expedited sticker service.

ALL OUTSTANDING TRAFFIC CITATIONS MUST BE TAKEN CARE OF BEFORE VEHICLE STICKERS ARE ISSUED

NOTICE OF INTENT TO HOLD PUBLIC HEARINGS ON UNMET PUBLIC TRANSIT NEEDS

The Transportation Development Act Statutes and California Code of Regulations provides that public hearings be held to receive testimony on whether or not there are public transportation needs which can be met through the Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 8 funds. The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (LACMTA) must make this determination before it can allocate funds provided by TDA Article 8 to projects other than public transit.

This determination will be made by LACMTA from a review of the Regional Transportation Plan, the testimony received at the public hearings, and the recommendation of the Los Angeles County Social Services Transportation Advisory Council. This hearing will be concerned with funding for the upcoming Fiscal Year 2026-2027. Comments are solicited relevant to the public transportation needs in the City of Avalon especially as they relate to the elderly, handicapped or low income, or to provide transportation in environmentally sensitive areas.
