ANNUAL VEHICLE REGISTRATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on February 2, 2026, the City of Avalon will begin annual Registration for all full-size Residential Vehicles and Autoette (Golf Cart) permits, and will continue through April 1, 2026. Vehicle permits renewed after this date shall be considered late and will be required to pay a "late renewal charge" of \$30.00 per vehicle in addition to the regular registration fee.

Full size residential vehicle permits shall be ineligible for renewal and shall be subject to losing all prior rights of registration if not renewed before 5:00 p.m. on Monday, June 1, 2026.

Applicants must bring current vehicle registration, proof of ownership or lawful possession, and be prepared to provide proof of residency or non-resident real property ownership. **The owner of a full-size residential vehicle(s), autoette(s) and non-residential autoette(s) must be present to register sticker. If the owner is unavailable, a letter must be provided from the owner designating a responsible person on their behalf.**

The fee for renewal is \$50.00 for permits. All renewals and payments may be completed online at: www.cityofavalon.gov/vehicles and will result in expedited sticker service.

ALL OUTSTANDING TRAFFIC CITATIONS MUST BE TAKEN CARE OF BEFORE VEHICLE STICKERS ARE ISSUED

Notice of Southern California Edison's Water and Gas Rate Increase Request

Southern California Edison (SCE) Company's Cost Recovery Application to the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) A.26-03-003

What is Being Requested for SCE Water?

SCE is requesting to recover a total of \$7.382 million (20.9%) of revenue over five years beginning in 2027, for costs recorded to various memorandum accounts. SCE proposes a revenue increase of approximately \$656.28 thousand in 2027 (6%) and \$1.68137 million annually from 2028 - 2031 (12-13%) through a surcharge to commercial and irrigation customers. The total dollar increase per customer class is shown in the table below.

Customer Class	Total \$ Increase Over 5 Years	% Increase
Commercial	\$7,068,865	21.2%
Irrigation	\$312,875	15.1%

How Would This Impact the Average Catalina Water Customer in Each of These Classes?

If the request is approved, commercial customers would see an average bill increase of approximately \$148.35 (11%) in 2027 and approximately \$380.10 (23-24%) for 2028-2031. Irrigation customers would see an average bill increase of approximately \$34.60 (8%) in 2027 and approximately \$88.64 (16-17%) for 2028-2031. The actual impact will vary based on usage and other factors.

What is Being Requested for SCE Gas?

SCE is requesting to recover \$544,128 of revenue in 2027-2028 (11.8% annual increase) for costs recorded to the Catastrophic Event Memorandum Account. This would be recovered from commercial customers through a surcharge.

How Would This Impact the Average Catalina Commercial Gas Customer?

If the request is approved, customers would see an average gas bill increase of approximately \$96.20 (8%). The actual impact will vary based on usage and other factors.
